16 CHINESE STUDENTS COMPLETE PRO PILOT COURSE AT US FLIGHT ACADEMY

Denton, TX – Mike Sykes, CEO of US Flight Academy, opened the graduation ceremonies for 16 Chinese students who began a professional pilot training course last November. Each student received a certificate verifying that they had successfully completed all training requirements as set forth by the Civil Aviation Administration of China in conjunction with the Federal Aviation Administration and conducted by US Flight Academy.

In the past ten months, they have completed Private Pilot Certification, Single Engine Airplane; Instrument Certification Course; Commercial Pilot Certification Course, Multi Engine Airplane; five hours of Upset Recovery and Spin Training; 20 hours High Performance Course, including flight time in a Beech C90; and the Air Transport Pilot Ground course.

“They covered a tremendous amount of material in a short period of time,” said Mike Sykes. “They deserve credit for being highly dedicated and motivated. They are returning to China where they will

have to pass China's exams for pilots and will then progress to extensive simulator training for various airliners."

Four of the students were recognized for special awards, including Best Overall Pilot, Wang Lei; Best Exam Average, Wang Zhijing; Best ATC Skills, Sun Ke; and Most Improved Pilot, Wang Jingbo.

This first group of Chinese students is being followed by four other groups, for a total of 162 students.
