PILOTS LOGGING RECORD TIMES AT US FLIGHT ACADEMY

Denton, TX – In the month of June, the US Flight Academy set a Personal Best record in rental and flight training hours. They recorded 3322 hours, of which 2547 were logged by students in their professional pilot training program. Then in July, they set new records, with 4428 total hours in training and rental. This time 3575 hours were part of the career pilot program.

US Flight Academy has several hundred active students pursuing everything from Sport Pilot through ATP ratings. They maintain several LSA trainers, a fleet of 15 Cessna 152s, and various aircraft up through a King Air C90.
