US AVIATION HOSTS A GROUP OF JUNIOR ROTC

Denton, TX – Denton High School has 80 students enrolled in their Junior ROTC program. Of those, eight kids signed up for a Private Pilot Ground School course that is designed to take them through the written exam. Three of the students have already indicated they plan to follow up immediately with flight training. So when seven of the eight showed up at US Aviation on Denton Airport, they were given a full tour of the Professional Flight Training facilities, the maintenance shop and the LSA showroom. They also sat in on a ground school session.

Later they were given a tour of the terminal building and control tower. The highlight of the day was a local flight over Denton in a Diamond DA-40. Lt. Col. Robert West, who heads up the Jr. ROTC program, said "it was an inspirational experience for these students. They were very attentive, enthusiastic and now seem committed to proceed with aviation in any way they can. It's amazing what a day at an airport can do for motivation."

US Aviation provides training from Sport Pilot up through the ATP written exam for professional pilots. They maintain a fleet of single and twin engine aircraft for training and charter operations.
